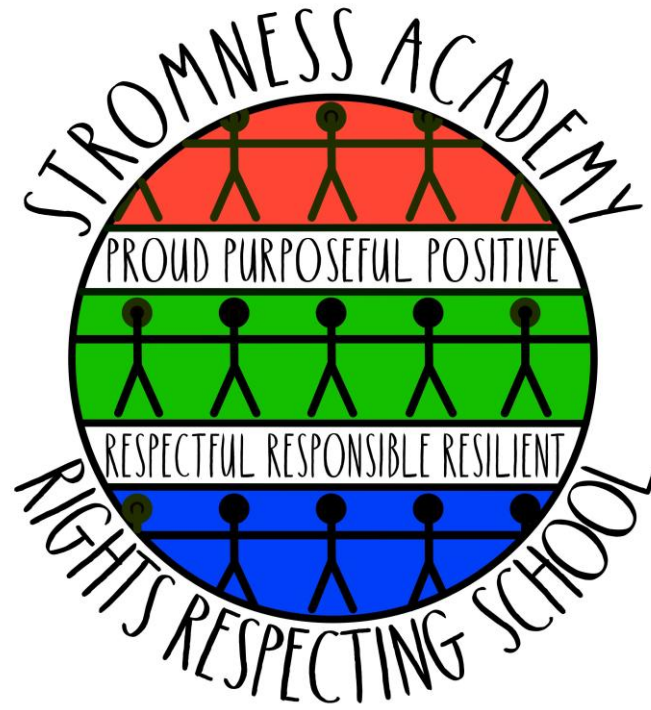

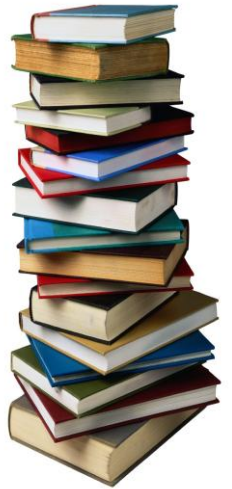
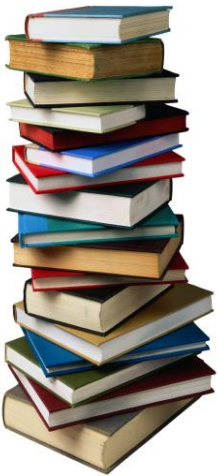

You would miss your activity for one week only. Please speak to Mr Flett to confirm whether or not you can play. Thank you.

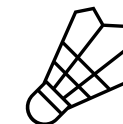
PE fitness suite timetable
