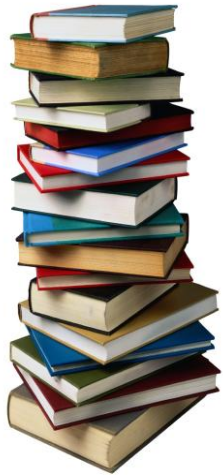
When the signs are up, you must be SILENT

- The toilets at the front of school will be closed during **break**. Please use the technical/art/ business toilets during the next two weeks.

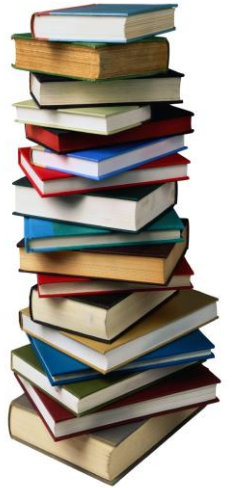

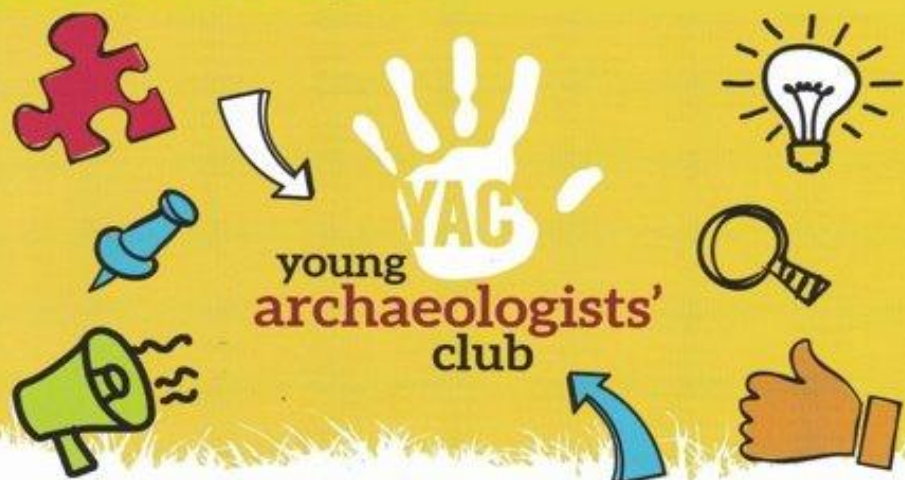
