Why take this course?

Recent research has shown that the only subject which teaches ALL the skills and capabilities which employers' value most highly, is Drama. It's a chance to work together closely and co-operatively with others, learn key communication skills, take some risks, think carefully about other people, work to deadlines, and organise complex activities.

- imagination
- negotiation and decision-making skills
- a willingness to try new things
- a willingness to listen to the ideas contributed by others
- a willingness to engage with an audience
- an open mind

Course content:

In S3 you will build on the Drama work done in your English classes during S1 and S2, in the following key areas:

- portraying character
- presenting work to an audience
- devising and/or rehearsing scripts
- using lighting and sound to create mood
- analysing scripts and performances

Course Assessment

You will be continuously assessed by your teacher, through a mixture of observation, conversation, performance and formal assessment submissions. You will receive regular feedback and advice on how to improve your work.
