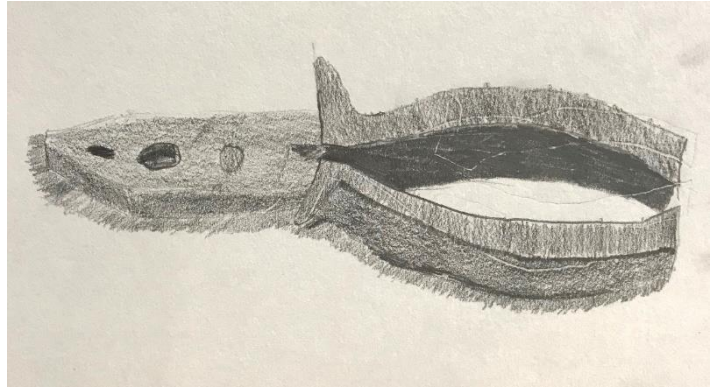


Art and Design - National 4

Why take this course?

It may be that you simply just enjoy art and design, and that you would like to continue to improve your artistic skills, or that you have a career path in mind that involves being creative. It's suited to students who have a real interest in art and design who are not quite ready to start National 5.

The course will build on your practical and creative experiences from S3. It will mainly focus on practical and visual skills supported with regular tutorials.

Course structure and Content (subject to change by the SQA)

National 4 – Course Structure and Content

This course consists of two mandatory Units:

Each of the component Units of the Course is designed to provide progression to National 5

Expressive Project

You will produce observational drawings in a chosen theme area such as landscape, still life or portraiture, leading through to a development stage culminating in the production of a final piece. You will also learn about other artists and their working practices.

Design Project

You will plan, research and develop creative design ideas in response to a given brief in areas such as jewellery, graphics or textiles, culminating in the production of a final design piece. You will also learn about other designers.

Course Assessment

Your coursework is assessed and marked internally in school.

Success at this level may lead to further study at National 5 Art and Design.
